Prof. Dr. Omid Majdani, Hannover, Germany

Biography:

Born 1971 in Tehran/Iran, Omid Majdani studied medicine at the Friedrich-Alexander-University of Erlangen-Nürnberg, Germany, and the Free University of Berlin, Germany. He obtained his medical and scientific training in Otorhinolaryngology at Hannover Medical School, Germany. In 2007 and 2008 he worked as Assistant Professor at the Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Nashville, TN. In 2010, he was appointed as Docent (PhD) for Otorhinolaryngology at Hannover Medical School. In 2015 he was appointed as Professor for Otolaryngology. Currently he is the vice chairman of the Clinic for Otolaryngology of the Hannover Medical School (Chairman: Prof. Prof. Dr. med. Th. Lenarz). He focuses on research topics “computer aided surgery, Simulation of surgical steps, navigation and robotics” as well as “development of new Cochlear Implant electrodes”. Clinically he is the Team leader for the Cochlear Implant and Skull base team.
