Prof. Dr. Uwe Baumann, Frankfurt/Main, Germany

Biography:

Uwe Baumann was born in Hildesheim, Germany, in 1961. He received his diploma in electrical engineering and information technology in 1989, and his Doctoral Degree in 1995 from the Technical University of Munich with his thesis on A Procedure for detection and extraction of multiple auditory objects. From 1989-1995, he worked on ear-related signal processing strategies as a member of the Acoustical Communication group (Prof. Dr.-Ing. E. Terhardt) at the Institute of Electroacoustics, headed by Prof. E. Zwicker (later renamed Institute of Man-Machine Communication, headed by Prof. M. Lang) at the Technical University of Munich. From 1995 to 2006, he worked in the Department of Experimental Audiology under Prof. K. Schorn at the University Hospital Großhadern, Ludwig-Maximilians-University, Munich.

During this period, he also completed his post-graduate studies in Medical Physics, leading to his graduation from the University of Kaiserslautern in 1998 and his approval by the German Society of Medical Physics. From 1989 to 1997 he was a member of the Munich special research group Hearing in Vertebrates. From 2001 to 2004 he was head of a sub-project in the Munich research unit Auditory Objects. In 2006 he was offered the position of Professor at Goethe-University Frankfurt/Main. He is currently the head of the Department of Audiological Acoustics at the ENT Department, directed by Prof. T. Stöver, and is responsible for research, teaching and clinical audio-technology in the field of hearing impairment.
